Reader: Be silent, all ye double-minded, who consider that the Godhead suffered. For the Lord of Glory was crucified in the flesh, but not crucified in His divine nature. We magnify Him who is one in two natures.

Glory to the Father and to the Son and to the Ho - ly Spi - rit.

Reader: Ye who deny the resurrection of the body, come to the tomb of Christ and be instructed; for the flesh of the Life-giver died, and then rose, that we might believe in the final Resurrection. We place our hope in Him.
